CHALLENGE 1 - BE VIABLE & SUSTAINABLE

- Deliver the new strategy for housing by reviewing the sustainability of the Supporting People model of operation, our existing housing asset base and by investing in new more appropriate property
- Ensure the new development at Lakeside achieves the Year 1 business plan projections
- Become more focussed on member retention supported by the introduction of a new membership model designed to improve family/junior usage and engagement
- V Develop our health-based programmes so they become more sustainable and community focused
- Mobilise the recently funded Y:Youth programme in Lancaster and review the financial performance of the YMCA Lancaster building
